COUNILLOR AND MAYOR, WILLIAM (BILL) SANDCHUCK RESIGNS FROM COUNCIL

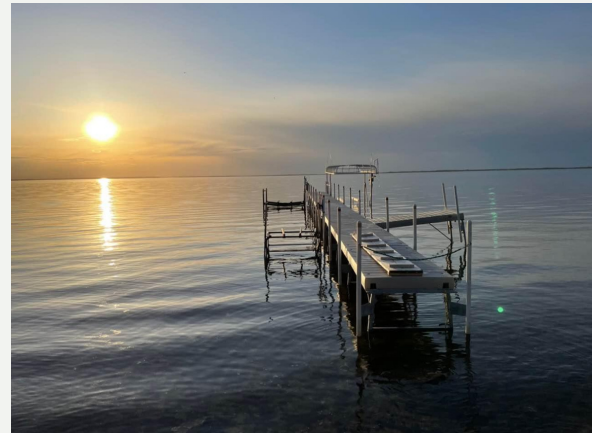

Qualification Requirements For Candidates in a Summer Village:

Candidates must:

- meet the voter eligibility requirements of 18 years or older,
- be a Canadian citizen,
- be named or have a spouse/partner who is named as owner on the title of property within the summer village, and
- have been a resident of Alberta for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding Election Day.

It is not necessary to be a full-time resident of the summer village but candidates must meet the requirements to vote in a summer village.
